



SCHOOL TAX CREDIT

In 1998, the State Legislature approved an addition to the Arizona tax law (ARS 43-10089.01) that allows taxpayers a credit of up to \$200 (\$400 for a married couple) if they contribute to the funding of extracurricular activities in public schools. A tax credit, unlike a tax deduction, is subtracted from the amount of taxes you owe. A tax credit is a full refund of your money.
